

SUMMARY OF FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2019-2020

Students

Two types of feedback from the students has been taken on curriculum enrichment and its implementation, learning process and over all evaluation of the course. Firstly, a general feedback of students has been collected on course content and its implementation. Majority of the students showed their positive response towards the content of courses and its implementation through the session. Responses of the students are as follows:

On the other hand, an overall evaluation feedback form is also obtained from the students on the course and its implementation. Most of the students find the course adequate but little challenging. The opinion of the students on whether the course justifies its goal is recorded in the following order: Fully, Moderately and Partially. On the level of understanding of the course content 66.67 % students think its manageable, for 25.93 % its easy, for 6.48 % its difficult and 0.93 % find its very difficult. Majority of students responded that 70 % to 100 % extent of the syllabus could be covered in the class. More than 50 % students find the quality of the course is good and around 40 % find it is excellent. Study material of the prescribed syllabus is easily available for the students. According to around 45 % students, the content of the course is partially similar to the same of the other universities. For more details, this information is given in the following form:
