## **Department of Political Science**

### **Course Outcome**

Department of Political Science stresses on the growth of the students' ability to check their knowledge, to increase their understanding level and to make them able to express their views regarding the subject.

The aim of the department is to enable students to

1. Study Political Science which has assumed greater significance in modern times.
2. Study Political Science which imparts them knowledge with regard to the State, Government and host of other political institutions.
3. Get knowledge of the state as it is of great significance to modern man. Politically enlightened people are capable of playing a useful part in social and political affairs.
4. Acquire deep understanding of the subject. The study of it makes them politically conscious which is an essential condition for the successful working of democracy.
5. Make them alert about their place in society by making them aware of their rights and responsibilities.
6. Tell them about different ideologies and helps them to formulate their own idea.
07. Create awareness among students about many attractive career options that include political journalism, civil services, administrative services, political advisors, federal, state and local government, research and teaching. Such candidates can also start their career in the field of law.

Outcomes of various courses taught by department of Political Science are;

#### **B.A.I**

Students will get the knowledge of various political theories and practices. They will understand the meaning and scope of the subject. They will get the knowledge about the relationship of Political Science with Economics, History and Sociology. Understanding about the origin of state and its functions will enrich them about their distinction from government, society and association. They will also get the knowledge about sovereignty. Rights and duties are another aspect of the course. The students will learn about the factors responsible for social change. They will also get understanding of concepts like liberty, equality, justice and democracy.

#### **B.A.II**

The students will acquire the knowledge of India's constitution as a central point of the course. Emerging trends in Indian federal system are taught in detail. Directive principles of state policy is another significant part of syllabus. Students will be taught about the role of president. They will also obtain knowledge about Indian parliament. Composition and powers of supreme court are also in the syllabus. Inclusion of role of governor, chief minister, state legislature and high court in the course gives better understanding of the government to the students. They will also learn about party system in India and roles played by religion and caste in Indian politics. The election commission is another aspect of Indian government which is important part of the course.

### B.A.III

The course consists mainly of comparative politics. They also study the political system of UK and USA. International politics and different approaches to it are the main highlights of the course contents.

Students get the knowledge about human rights and regional originations. They also study national power and its elements. United Nations is another aspect of their learning in this course.
