- Moreover, students may become social worker, writer/subject expert and travel tourism expert by extreme knowledge of historical monuments.

Course Outcome of Subject History:-

B.A. I

Paper-I : History of India upto 1000 AD

Students can achieve knowledge regarding the main sources of ancient Indian History and geographical features of India. They learn about Indus Valley civilization, Vedic civilization, later Vedic civilization, Maurya Dynasty, Gupta Dynasty, The Vardhana Dynasty, Dynasties in south and Rajputs. Students learn about Jainism and Buddhism also.

Paper-II : History of India 1000 AD to 1707 AD

Students will get knowledge about the invasions of Mahmud Ghaznavi and Mohammad Ghauri. Students will acquire knowledge about administration, socio-cultural, political and economic conditions of Delhi Sultanate, Mughals, Sher Shah Suri, Rajputs and Shivaji.

B.A. II

Paper-I : History of India 1707 AD -1950 AD

Modern India history is very essential and important for students. They will get knowledge about the penetration, expansion and consolidation of British rule in India. Indian awakening, cultural changes and socio-religious reforms movements, revolt of 1857, Indian national congress, role of Mahatma Gandhi, partition of India are described in this paper.

Paper-II : History of Punjab (1469 AD -1799 AD)

Students will conversant with the main sources of Punjab history and political, social, religious condition of Punjab at the time of Guru Nanak Dev Ji. They learn about the sikh history mainly the Guru period. They get knowledge about the sikh gurus , Banda Singh Bahadur, Dal Khalsa, Political struggle of Sikhs against Mughal Subedar of Lahore and administration of Sikh Misals.

B.A. III

Paper-I : History of World (1500-1950)

The students of History learn about significant events of world history. Such as Renaissance, reformation, French revolution of 1789, Neapolian Bonapart, Vienna Congress, Unification of Germany and Italy, Industrial revolution, First world war, Russian revolution 1917, Nazism in Germany and Fasism in Italy, Second world war, Chinese revolution of 1949. All these incorporated topics in this paper.

Paper-II : History of Punjab (1799-1966)

In this paper students will acquaint about the History of Maharaja Ranjit Singh. Students get knowledge about political condition of Punjab on the eve of Ranjit Singh's accession to power, his conquests, relation between Ranjit Singh and British, administration of Ranjit Singh, Anglo-Sikh Wars, Annexation of Punjab, Board of administration, Socio-Religious reforms movements, partition of Punjab and reorganization of Punjab. These are the main important topics of this paper.
